By road

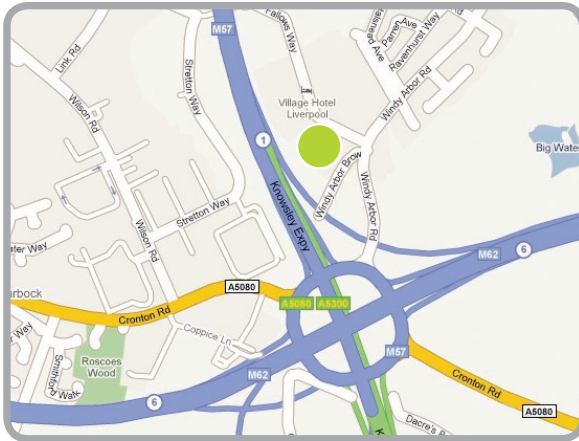

Palliative Care Course for General Practitioners

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Introduction

Recognising and managing patients at the end of life can be extremely challenging.

This course delivered over 3 evenings focuses on recognition and assessment, symptom management, ethical decision making and care planning for those who are likely to be in the last days of life.

Each session will be led by a Specialist in Palliative Medicine. All sessions will be interactive and focused on the learning needs of GPs.

The course is the result of collaboration between 3 Specialist Palliative Care Services from across Liverpool, Sefton, St.Helens and Knowsley.

Course Description

3 monthly evening sessions spread between February and April 2015.

Sessions run from 18.30 to 21.00 hrs with an evening meal at the start.

Senior Clinicians from Palliative Medicine and the different specialities will lead and facilitate the evening.



Aims of the Course

The course will:

- Provide evidence based updates on symptom management topics.
- Provide information about emerging approaches to symptom control.
- Provide opportunity for facilitated group discussions of real cases.

Cost

£75 for 3 evening sessions.
