Any individual can sell at our car boot sales as long as they comply with these terms and conditions and they are NOT TRADERS.

The car boot sale will take place on the car park of the above address.

Sellers will be allowed onsite from 07.30am. Buyers will be allowed onsite from 9am. No selling is allowed before 9am. We will close at 1pm and all sellers must be off the premise by 14.30pm.

All sellers must give their names to the organiser on arrival and you will be told where your allotted space is.

In the case of extreme weather conditions and if we have to cancel the event, we will notify you via email or phone call - please check prior to the event.

Refunds will not be given should you fail to take up your position or you fail to attend.

Stalls and dates are non-transferable under any circumstances. In the case of a cancelled event, sellers will be given the option to attend at the next available event or a full refund will be given.

Willowbrook Hospice does not take responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen goods.

Goods bought or sold at Car Boot Sale are at the vendors and customers own risk and are not directly linked to Willowbrook Hospice. We do not take responsibility for the goods sold.

Willowbrook Hospice reserves the right to decline entry to anyone at their own discretion regardless of whether an entry fee as a trader has been already paid, and without refund or compensation.

You can sell anything that is safe, legal and belongs to you other than the below prohibited goods :-
Stolen goods, any item deemed to be a weapon - including kitchen knives, counterfeit goods, pornographic material or any material deemed offensive by hospice staff, all food lines, (with the exception of authorised food traders & lines) sweets, drinks, newspapers, magazines, tobacco, alcohol, catalogue returns, weapons of all description, drugs and medication, fireworks, flammable liquids and gas canisters, live animals, and new toys without a CE safety mark. Any seller found selling any items listed above will be asked to refrain for selling them immediately; if they persist they will be asked to leave.

Under Health and Safety the following second hand goods are prohibited from sale All cookers and Fires (gas/electric), all washing machines and fridges. All cosmetics, toiletries,

all babies and children's car seats. Any seller found selling any items listed above will be asked to refrain for selling them immediately; if they persist they will be asked to leave.

Any items left on site at the end of the event will be donated to Willowbrook Hospice to be sold from our donation warehouse, without compensation.

Who is classed as a trader?

If you buy goods to resell, for example from paper adverts, or a cash and carry, then you are classed as a trader.

If you attend car boot sales every couple of months or more then you are classed as a trader.

Do you employ anyone to help you with sales? If so, you are probably a trader.

If you sell similar goods at other venues – for example, markets, in the street or from home then you are classed as a trader.

FAQ's

Q- Do I need to bring my own table?

A- Yes. We will not be providing tables on the day so please make sure you have one with you.

Q- Can I bring a Gazebo?

A- Yes. You are able to bring a gazebo but there will only be room for a small one.

Q- How do I book a pitch?
